## DRESS/ATTIRE

Please label your child's clothing and personal items. It is the parent's responsibility to **ensure** their child is properly equipped for a safe and successful summer experience.

**If your child cannot participate in the daily activities due to sore or blistered feet, they will need to stay home, or you will be responsible for finding alternative care.**

## FIELDTRIPS

All fieldtrips are listed on the School Age Calendar. A monthly planner will be posted for your convenience in the entrance by Kelly's Office. Check the center calendar weekly for updates or cancellations.

**To assure the safety of all the children, it is our policy that children may NOT join a field trip already in progress.**

For this **reason**, it is very **important** that parent take note of the **departure** time of each field trip and plan **accordingly**. If a child "misses the bus", the parent will be **responsible** for finding alternative care for their child; **however**, to avoid your child's disappointment – plan ahead.

**TRANSPORTATION:** The majority of the activities/field trips will be within walking range. It is the parents' responsibility to ensure that your child is equipped with good walking shoes daily. Children with poor foot wear that complain of sore feet will be sent home.

Summer Curriculum includes social interactions, literacy, nature, science and sensory exploration, family and community involvement, physical development and learning as a play-based model. As weather permits, many of the activities are outdoors.







